### FELTHAM HEROICS IN VAIN AS OLDFIELD D TRIUMPH

A treble from Raymond Hall gave newly promoted Oldfield E their first win of the season against Mayfield B. Keith Walter weighed in with two wins before teaming up with Hall to take the final set doubles and with it the match 6-4. Nigel Woolley's brace was best for Mayfield.

Ken Milsom, who missed most of last season through illness, is returning to something like his best form and his hat trick was the highlight of Key Centre's 7-3 win away to Bathford D in Division 2. Dave Carter also won two sets for the visitors only losing to the improving Julian Kashdan at 11-6 in the fifth game. Twerton St Michaels registered an emphatic 10-0 win against St Barnabas C. Mark Creedon, Peter Smith and James Stone were the successful Twerton trio.

In the Premier Division a hard fought maximum from Bob Murray prevented Mayfield A slipping to a second successive defeat against Oldfield C (pictured right).

Murray's haul included fifth game victories over Nigel Dagger and Paul Redman both of whom were impressive in defeating Linda Porter and Chris Dunn.
